Item 1: Approving the Minutes of the last meeting and the Action Taken Report.

**Item 2**: The meeting expressed its concern over the fall in admissions last year. It was decided to offer new fee package this year to attract more students to Jyothi.

B.Tech: 1) Instead of 1 year fee, initially we will collect only S1 fees.

- 2) The Refundable Deposit of Rs. 1 Lakh Is waived to those who are willing to pay interest @ 10% for the same.
- 3) Scholarships are generously granted to those who have KEAM Rank upto 25000. This package considerably reduced the fees to be remitted at the time of joining in the college.

The admission target for the Academic year 2016 - 17 is 90%.

M.Tech: 1. It was decided to grant scholarship of 26000/- per Sem to M.Tech students reducing the Fees in S1 to Rs. 47,150/- and remaining semesters to Rs. 40,000/- per sem.

2. Alumnae of Jyothi will get an additional Scholarship of Rs. 10,000/- per Sem.

B.Tech (LE) 1. Refundable Deposit of Rs. 1 lakh is waived.

Caution Deposit is reduced to Rs. 5000/- Instead of Rs. 10,000/-
